

School Attainment Data

Below is the school attainment data based on teacher assessment in the summer term of 2021.

The data does not form a complete picture of achievement at our school which is measured by the individual progress a child makes and which is reported to you in terms of above/ below or expected progress in the End of Year Report and Parent's Evenings.

It is a snapshot of attainment by that group of children. It does not show the individual progress that children make each year.

The data also includes those children in the Orry's Unit with profound learning and developmental difficulties. This data is representative of an academic year containing two periods of lockdown and a year prior to this containing an extended lockdown, which will have had an impact on children's learning.
