Main learning objectives:

- Count, read and write numbers to 50 in numerals.
- Count on in multiples of 2s, 5s and 10s.
- Understand, complete and investigate one step problems that involve + and - using concrete objects, pictorial representations and missing number problems
- Solve one step problems involving multiplication and division by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays (with the support of the teacher).

Science

Main learning objectives:

- I can talk about changes in light, sound or movement that result from actions [e.g. switching on a simple electrical circuit, pushing and pulling objects].
- I know that sound and light come from a variety of sources.
- I can name some sources of sound and light.

Activity ideas:

- Sources of light hunt then sort into natural and manmade.
- Create Disney characters stick puppets and use to retell stories using torches (could film for ICT).
- Investigate shadows provide chn with questions and work together to plan how we could find the answer.
- Have torches and reflective items in the role play area to investigate light and reflectors.

Listening to then creating own simple tunes with a short and long sounds


RE (PPA cover) Main learning objectives:
