Numeracy

Focus areas: Multiplication and Division

Main learning objectives:

- I use multiplication and division facts for multiplication tables up to 10 x 10.
- I can multiply together three numbers.
- Count from 0 in multiples of 6,7,9,25 and 1000.
- Use distributive law and understanding of place value to multiply digit numbers times 1 digit numbers (partitioning to multiply).

Use appropriate mental and written methods to solve multiplication and division problems.

- Divide by grouping/ simple chunking.

- I can identify rock types.
- I can sort and classify rocks.
- I know how the digestive system works.
