Science

- Some forms of energy are associated with heat, light, electricity, movement and sound.
- · Darkness is the absence of light.
- Light travels in straight lines and can be reflected and refracted.
- Light has a speed.
- · White light is made of different colours.
- Light can travel through liquids, solids and gases.
- Objects are seen because light travels from the light sources to our eyes, or from light sources to objects and then to our eyes.
- Shadows have the same shape as the objects that cast them because light travels in straight lines.
- The distance of an object from the light source and its opacity changes the shadow formed

Activities: Creating shadows, making periscopes, reflection/ refraction, how the eye works and see's light
